

What is the YCW and Impact?

The YCW is a movement for young people aged 17-30 who meet in small groups. They focus on their everyday experiences as young adults, reflect on them in light of Gospel values and commit themselves to take action (See, Judge, Act).

Impact is a programme for young people aged 13-17 who meet in groups in parishes or schools. They use this same method to make a difference in their lives and the lives of other young people.

As a national movement, the YCW and Impact in England and Wales offers the chance for young people from across the country to gather, meet and share their experiences. This enables them to 'be the difference' on a wider scale.

The YCW in England and Wales is a member of the International Coordination of Young Christian Workers (ICYCW), which is present in 60 countries across the world.

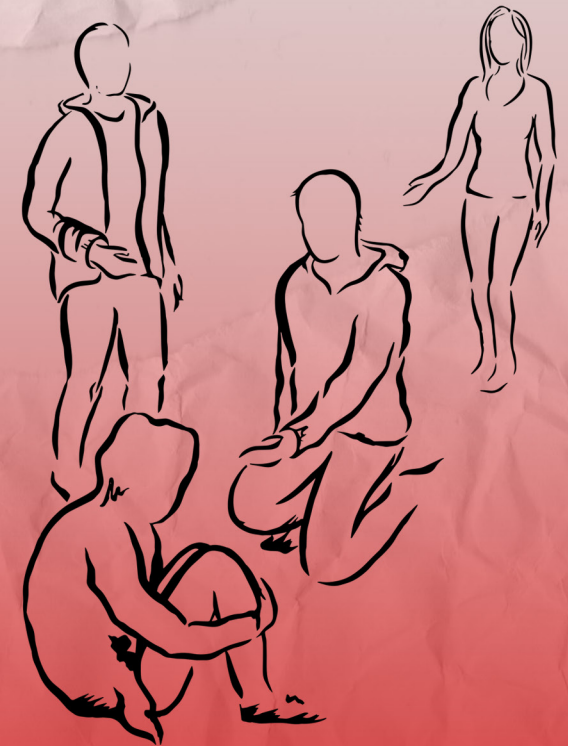
